

Choice of Roof Glazing

The Vesta Veranda offers a choice of three roof glazing materials.

Glass Roof

Our most popular glazing is our 8.8mm clear laminated safety glass. The glass roof offers the advantage of no loss of natural light to the internal rooms. You will also benefit from the unobstructed views out through the roof. We glaze all our glass roofs in single sheets of glass over the full depth, this means that there will be no un-sightly joins in the roof that could leak or attract moss leaving you with a sleek streamlined roof finish. Please note that the maximum depth we can offer with a glass roof is 3500mm into the garden.

16mm Clear Polycarbonate

Our clear polycarbonate roof offers the advantage of being able to span further distances due its weight and the fact that it is unbreakable so we can offer a polycarbonate roof option projecting up to 5000mm into the garden. The polycarbonate will also offer some privacy due to its opaque makeup so is very suitable for homes in built up areas that may be overlooked

16mm Opal Polycarbonate

The Opal polycarbonate roof offers all of the benefits of the clear polycarbonate but the milky white colour offers total sun protection to clients who want to block UV light and create a safer environment for children to play.

Concealed Guttering



The Vesta Veranda has a choice of two gutter options, the Vesta and the Vesta Plus. Both options offer fully concealed gutters so no nasty gutter brackets, no sagging gutters. The downpipe is concealed within one of the upright posts and this can be connected underground to your existing

rainwater system so gutters or downpipes are visible, This creates a very neat finish. The **Vesta Plus** gutter system is a heavier steel reinforced gutter and ring beam allowing a longer span between posts, this option will reduce the number of posts required.

Maintenance Free



All of our Verandas are totally maintenance-free other than the usual cleaning. As standard, we finish all our roofs on the exterior with aluminium cappings to ensure a lifelong finish. The main structure is powder coated aluminium so there is no fear of rust and the structure will simply require a wipe down once or twice a year to keep it looking pristine.



Foundation Options

All verandas must be securely anchored to a concrete foundation base. Fixing to a paved patio or a timber deck is not recommended. If you are considering building a new patio then this should be built after the Veranda has been installed as the paving will need to be cut in around the Veranda posts.

If you have decking in place already



An existing decking will not be suitable to anchor a veranda firmly to the ground.

A veranda roof can act like a sail catching the wind, creating significant uplift during winter storms and weather alerts. Your deck boards will have been fixed with fixing brackets or just directly screwed to the joists using wood screws, if these screws rust over time or if they are <u>simply not adequate</u> for the force of the wind, then your veranda may move. Also you need to consider that the average weight of the glass in a veranda roof will be over 500kg and this weight will be transferred down to just 2 or 3 posts, so this represents a significant load on the decking board.

If your veranda does not have an adequate foundation it is not likely to blow away but movement may cause the glass in the roof to crack, or if using polycarbonate sheeting, the sheets may become dislodged from the rafters.

We recommend removing some of your deck boards to create space to install concrete foundation pads, once the veranda has been installed the deck boards can then be cut around the veranda posts, then you have the peace of mind that your veranda has been properly constructed.

If you have a patio installed already



If you have a patio already installed then some sections will need to be lifted to allow for the concrete foundation pads to be installed, the paving can then be reinstated and cut around the veranda posts after the veranda has been installed. We can quote for this work locally or we can offer guidance and specifications if you wish to do this work yourself. Please note for Porcelain patios you will need your original contractor to carry out this work.

Drainage Options


The Vesta range has a cleverly designed concealed gutter and downpipe system which creates sleek lines and ensures there are no unsightly downpipes etc visible. The rainwater downpipe is concealed within the upright posts and this can then exit underground if you have drainage located nearby.

Otherwise the rainwater pipe can exit just above the ground level to drain away.

Adaptations

Adaptations for pipes on your house wall

Many homes may have pipes from the toilets or rainwater pipes in the way, we can offer solutions for most circumstances. The roof pitch of the veranda can be altered to allow the roof go above the pipes or below the pipes or the pipes can be brought through the roof. If bringing the pipes through the roof we alter the glass sizes and install a solid panel to allow the pipe travel through the roof and be sealed correctly.





Veranda Post Options

Your Vesta Veranda will require upright posts at intervals to support the roof. Please see the guide below for the number of posts required for each size of Veranda, it is also dependent on the type of roof glazing

We offer the Vesta and Vesta plus range. The Vesta Plus range is more expensive but comes with a reinforced ring beam which reduces the number of posts required .



Vesta Standard Sizes With Polycarbonate Roof




Vesta Standard Sizes 8.8mm With Laminated glass
